**Costs:**

- \$210 per scout; 50% Deposit (\$105.00) Due **February 21st**, Balance Due **April 24th**.
- \$80 Full Time Adults; Part Time Adult Fees (calculated on attached page)

Furthermore, by my signature below, I agree to indemnify and hold harmless the Released parties from any expense, including attorneys' fees (including the cost of defending any claim released by this agreement), as to any and all claims released under this agreement on behalf of my Child and/or myself. I further authorize the Released Parties to provide to my Child or to me, through medical personnel of their choice, customary medical assistance, transportation, and emergency medical services. This consent, however, does not impose a duty upon any of the Released Parties to provide such assistance, transportation or services. This instrument shall be governed by Indiana law, notwithstanding any state's choice of law rules to the contrary.
